[20] Americans Working Abroad: U.S. taxpayers working abroad have a larger foreign earned income exclusion in 2022. It jumped from \$108,700 for 2021 to \$112,000 for 2022. (Taxpayers claim the exclusion on Form 2555(opens in new tab).)

The standard ceiling on the foreign housing exclusion is also increased from \$15,218 to \$15,680 for 2022 (although overseas workers in many high-cost locations around the world qualify for a significantly higher exclusion).
