

## 2015 Week #1 Quiz Rulings

**Ruling 1:** *Game ends. Final score is A29-B28.* In 2011 the Exception in 4-1-3-b was expanded to allow the ball to remain alive if the kicker was in position to kick the ball at the moment the ball was snapped. As result of this change, the grounded holder can pass the ball (forward or backward) or run with the ball.

**Ruling 2:** *No score. Extra period ends. A 1/10 B-40 or A 1/10 B-121/2.* The 15-yard penalty is enforced to start the second extra period. When there is a live ball foul after a change of team possession in extra periods, penalties for flagrant personal and unsportsmanlike fouls are enforced on the succeeding play (3-1-3-g-1).

**Ruling 3:** *Touchdown (2 points). A f/k A-20.* Most distance penalties for fouls after a change of team possession during a try are declined by rule. However, penalties for flagrant personal fouls, unsportsmanlike conduct fouls, dead-ball personal fouls and live-ball fouls treated as dead-ball fouls are enforced on the succeeding kickoff or at the succeeding spot in extra periods. The penalty for A64's live-ball personal foul is declined by rule. The 15-yard penalty for A14's unsportsmanlike foul is enforced on the succeeding kickoff (8-3-4-a).

**Ruling 4:** *Game ends. Final score is A27-B28.* Because Team B does not snap the ball, the game clock starts on the ready after penalty enforcement for B96's foul (3-2-d-3). A65's false start foul stops the clock. Team B will accept the penalty and elect the ZAP 10.

**Ruling 5:** *B 1/10 A-29 Snap.* The scrimmage kick must cross the neutral zone in order for Team B to take penalty enforcement at the dead-ball spot (6-3-13). Team A failed to earn a first down. Team B will decline the penalty for A's illegal formation foul and take possession at the dead ball spot.

**Ruling 6:** *A 1/goal B-2. Extend the period.* The result of the play is a touchback. The penalty is enforced from the end of the last run when that run ends beyond the neutral zone and there is no change of team possession during the down. The change of team possession occurred after the down (8-6-2).

**Ruling 7:** *B 1/10 B-7.* The penalty for B56's foul is completed first. Since Team B is in possession when the down ends, the foul carries postscrimmage kick enforcement. Team A will most likely accept the penalty enforced half the distance from the end of the kick, the B-14. If Team A declines the penalty - highly unlikely - Team B would have the option to replay the down or put the ball in play 1/10 at the spot of the fumble.
