

2015 NCAA Football Rules & Interpretations Quiz Week #7

RULING FORMAT: Team (A or B) in possession, down, distance and succeeding spot – example A 1/10 A-40. Include additional relevant information *e.g.* which play clock to be used and when the game clock starts. Also resolve any fouls, violations, inadvertent whistle, Zap 10, extension of the period, disqualifications, etc.

Play 1: Third & 12 on the B-32. B44 intercepts A17's pass on B's 4 and his momentum carries him into B's end zone where he fumbles. As A77 attempts to recover the ball, B77 pulls A77's jersey on B's 2. Grounded B77 recovers the ball on the B-4.

Play 2: Third and 21 on the B-31. A10 scrambles and runs out of bounds on B's 12. During A10's run, A64 held B96 on B's 29. Immediately after A10 went out of bounds, A66 threw B54 down by the face mask on B's 28. Game clock?

Play 3: Fourth & 11 on the B-26. Second series of an extra period. A6's field goal attempt is blocked but continues downfield. B44 picks up the ball on B's 10 and is tackled on the B-15. During the kick, B45 blocked A80 below the waist on B's 18.

Play 4: Free kick on the A-35. A5's kick is rolling near A's 45 when A84 voluntarily steps out of bounds. While one foot still out of bounds on the A-44 and the other foot inbounds, A84 picks up the ball on A's 46.

Play 5: Fourth & 10 on the B-30. Potential holder, A4 has his knee on the ground and A7 is in positioned to kick the ball. A4 receives the snap and immediately passes the ball to blocking back A36 who advances to B's 22 where he fumbles. The ball is batted backward by B94 and rolls out of bounds on B's 18. At the snap, B44 ran forward toward the neutral zone, leaped and landed on right guard A66.

Play 6: Third & 16 on the A-24. Runner, A36 advances to A's 27 where B55 pulls his face mask causing him to fumble. B68 recovers and advances to A's 8 when an inadvertent whistle sounds. Game clock?

Play 7: Fourth & 10 on the B-30. The score is A27-B28. B44 intercepts A18's pass and runs out of bounds on B's 24. Team B was offside. Five seconds remain in the fourth quarter. The referee announces to the free world that the penalty is accepted, the down will be replayed and the clock will start on the ready for play. As the referee is winding the clock, Team A sends in the field goal team. Team B makes no attempt to substitute. Time expires before the ball is snapped.
