2014 REPLAY QUIZ #13

- 1. 4/5 @ B-15 with 0:10 remaining in the 4th Quarter and the score A-10, B14. From the B-20, quarterback A12 is hit at about the same time as he begins his throwing motion. The ball is caught by A73 at the B-14 (0:06) and he is tackled at the B-9 (0:02). The Referee rules that A12:
 - a. fumbled the ball, but replays show that he threw a forward pass.

Reverse to a forward pass, which will also make A73 guilty of illegal touching. The penalty is five yards from the previous spot, bringing up 4/10 @ B-20. The clock remains at 0:02 and will start on the Ready.

b. threw a forward pass, but replays show that he fumbled the ball.

Reverse to a fourth down fumble, which is dead when caught by A73. The ball is returned to the spot of the fumble, bringing up B - 1/10 @ B-20. Reset the clock to 0:06 and start on the Snap.

- 2. 3/10 @ B-30. A42 carries the ball to the B-21 where he is ruled down. Replays show that A42 fumbled the ball at the B-21, and that in the immediate continuing action at the B-19:
 - a. the ball was recovered by A85.

Reverse to A - 1/10 @ B-19. Suggested announcement: "After further review, the ball was fumbled with a clear recovery by <Team A>. It will be 1st and 10 for <Team A> at the 19-yard line."

b. the ball was recovered by B17.

Reverse to B - 1/10 @ B-19. Suggested announcement: "After further review, the ball was fumbled with a clear recovery by <Team B>. It will be 1st and 10 for <Team B> at the 19-yard line."

c. it is uncertain who recovered the ball.

Ruling of A - 4/1 @ B-21 Stands. Suggested announcement: "After further review, the ball was fumbled, but there was no clear recovery by either team. By rule, the ruling on the field stands. It will be 4th and 1 for <Team A> at the 21-yard line."

- 3. 2/15 @ B-45 with 0:16 remaining in the 4th Quarter and the score A-17, B-21. A36 is hit and stumbles near the B-30, but regains his balance and carries the ball across B's goal line. Replays show that, with 0:08 remaining on the clock, A36's arm touched the ground with the ball at the:
 - a. B-29 and that A36 crossed the goal line with 0:00 on the clock. Team A has no time outs remaining.

Reverse to 1/10 @ B-29. Reset the clock to 0:08 because the line-to-gain was reached. Start on the Ready.

- b. B-31 and that A36 crossed the goal line with 0:00 on the clock. Team A has:
 - i. <u>one</u> time out remaining.

Reverse to 3/1 @ B-31. Reset the clock to 0:08 and charge Team A with their final time out. The lineto-gain was not reached, so the clock would have remained running, but since Team A had a time out remaining and time <u>expired</u>, they may use the time out at the point the ball became dead. Start the clock on the Snap because of the time out. See 2014 Replay Case Book Play #134.

ii. <u>no</u> time outs remaining.

Reverse to 3/1 @ B-31. Game over because the line-to-gain was not reached, so the clock would not have stopped. Time expired, and Team A had no time outs.

- c. B-31 and that A36 crossed the goal line with 0:02 on the clock. Team A has:
 - i. <u>one</u> time out remaining.

Reverse to 3/1 @ B-31. Clock remains at 0:02 because the line-to-gain was not reached. The fact that Team A had a time out remaining is only of consequence in resetting the clock if time <u>expires</u>, but they will likely take the time out so the clock starts on the Snap rather than the Ready. See 2014 Replay Case Book Play #134.

ii. <u>no</u> time outs remaining.

Reverse to 3/1 @ B-31. Clock remains at 0:02 because the line-to-gain was not reached, so the clock would not have stopped. Start the clock on the Ready.
