

REPLAY FOR NON-REPLAY TYPES - 2012

Pass or Fumble [26]

Reverse fumble to incomplete pass: {61}{65}

- [1] Ball leaves passer's hand before hand reaches forward point beyond body. {65}
 - a. Adjust clock if needed.

Reverse incomplete pass to fumble:

- [1] Potential passer loses ball before hand come forward. {63}
- [2] Must be catch or recovery in immediate continuing action. {62}{67}
 - a. Team possession awarded but not any advance.
- [2] Incomplete pass ruling stands if no clear recovery in immediate continuing action. {64}
- [3] Reversal could result in fourth down fumble rule. {66}

Not reviewable:

- [1] Replay can rule on incomplete forward pass but not potential grounding. {68}
