

REPLAY FOR NON-REPLAY TYPES - 2012

Scoring Plays [37]

Position of ball in relation to goal line:

- [1] Reviewable going in and coming out of end zone. {107}
 - a. Entire ball must be in field of play when coming out. {118}

Plays at pylon (no difference if ball carrier leaves feet voluntarily or due to contact:

- [1] Airborne player who lands out of bounds must get ball inside or over pylon. {108}{109}
- [2] If any part of ball carrier touches inbounds in end zone or pylon before hitting ground out of bounds, he gets the goal line outside the pylon. {110}
- [3] Player touching pylon when ball has penetrated goal line outside the pylon has scored a touchdown. {111}
- [4] Succeeding spot is where ball crossed sideline if no touchdown. {112}
- [5] Ball breaks plane of goal line inside pylon after official rules ball carrier out of bounds close to goal line. {113}
- [6] Ball carrier lands in end zone with “step and dive” after official rules ball carrier out of bounds close to goal line. {114}

Pass in end zone:

- [1] Forward progress in end zone similar to forward progress in field of play. {115}{118}

Official rules touchdown but ball carrier loses ball before scoring:

- [1] Touchback if ball goes out of bounds in end zone in immediate continuing action. {116}
- [2] Team’s ball at spot of fumble if loose ball declared dead in end zone with no player possession. {117}
 - a. Team’s ball at spot of recovery if loose ball declared dead in field of play.

Field goals:

- [1] Reviewable up to the top of the upright. {119}{120}

Not reviewable:

- [1] Official rules ball carrier steps on sideline. Ball becomes dead. {121}
 - a. Exception: Ball carrier takes one step and leaps into end zone. {113}{114}
- [2] Official rules ball carrier down but he is not down. {122}
- [3] Foul taking place in field of play or end zone. {123}
- [4] Spot of pass when intentional grounding involves a safety. {124}
